Dear Residents & Families,

The majority of our campus received the second dose of the Pfizer vaccine on 1/23/21. It has now been 2 weeks allowing for the greatest possible immunity.

As discussed at our recent General Assembly on February 4th, we are now allowing for greater engagement for our residents that have received both of their vaccines (second dose on 1/23).

The following activities are opened back up with an understanding that all of our residents and staff will continue to adhere to the required safety precautions recommended by the Centers for Disease Control:

Activities opening:

- 1) Shopping trips
- 2) Visiting family off campus (preferably outside)
- 3) Visiting with fellow residents on campus indoors if both parties are vaccinated.
- 4) Activity outings (country rides)
- 5) Outdoor dining as weather permits. (Hopefully, indoor dining soon)
- 6) Hair salons that follow the County restrictions are approved both on and off campus.

Precautions that will needed to be followed:

- 1) Wear your mask when out in public or with family and friends.
- 2) Please make sure mask is covering both your mouth and nose.
- 3) Continue to practice social distancing and try and socialize outside vs. inside.
- 4) Continue to wash and sanitize hands frequently and avoid touching your face and mask.

I recognize how difficult these times are for all of our residents and families but want to remind everyone that this virus continues to grow with multiple variants. It is up to all of us to continue to be diligent in following the precautions to keep everyone safe within our community.
